The PG & Research Dept. of Social Work organized one day Regional Seminar on Prevention and Treatment of Child Sexual Abuse on 9th February, 2016 in collaboration with Center for the Prevention & Treatment of Child Sexual Abuse, Quezon City, Philippines on 9th February, 2016. at DMT Hall in Sacred Heart College. Dr. Lois J Engelbrecht from Quezon City, Philippines is the resource person. She is the Board Member and Founder of Centre for the Prevention and Treatment of Child Sexual Abuse. This centre exists in Philippines, Vietnam, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, China and India. She has done here Master of Social Work in University of Washington Seattle and Ph.D in Social Work in Walden University, USA.
